

CHS Band Booster Meeting Minutes  
July 18, 2013

- I. Minutes from June's meeting were reviewed
- II. Uniforms
  - a. Old uniforms will be stored in the boxes from the new uniforms
  - b. A photo of a student wearing an old uniform will be taken for use in selling the old uniforms on-line
  - c. The uniforms need to be posted on ebay or a used uniform site
  - d. We have documentation from the district allowing us to sell them
  - e. A volunteer is needed to oversee the sale of the used uniforms
- III. Apparel
  - a. All apparel is ready
  - b. A PDF file will be made with pictures and prices
  - c. All apparel money will go into a separate account
- IV. Marching Band Budget
  - a. The budget has been adjusted to reflect current enrollment numbers
  - b. It includes approximately \$2,000 for corporate sponsors, although there are contact/communication issues still being worked out regarding sponsors
  - c. Food budget was adjusted to line up with last year's
  - d. Student Fees
    - i. A "Fee Hardship Form" has been created to help students who are struggling to pay. Its purpose is communication and to get the student involved.
    - ii. Students must first approach Mr. Brien and he will work with them filling out the form.
    - iii. Fee assistance scholarships will be \$25 or \$50
    - iv. Payment options/plans will be discussed
  - e. The current fee plan is working well as there are funds available to cover costs
  - f. Vibraphone may be ordered at the end of July pending funds and ensuring uniforms are taken care of first
  - g. Tower
    - i. The district needs to be willing to insure the tower, so Mr. Brien has sent pictures to see what will be approved
    - ii. A tower builder has been lined up
    - iii. Parker Rogers is planning to build the fence tower as a scout project. Mrs. Rogers will approach the Diamondbackers for funding as the football team will also be able to use the tower.
- V. Fall Camp
  - a. Schedule will be completed soon
  - b. A letter will be mailed home next week that will include policies
  - c. Food
    - i. 1<sup>st</sup> week – snacks only; 2<sup>nd</sup> week – snacks all week, students bring own lunch on Monday and Tuesday, Wednesday through Friday lunch and dinner will be provided
    - ii. Healthy snacks are important with maybe one "reward" treat of gummy bears
    - iii. Gatorade will be provided for part of the day but water should be their main drink

- iv. Performance Day BBQ – band will provide meats and buns. Each grade or section will be assigned sides
- VI. Car Wash – August 21, 5-7pm
  - a. Location most likely Alameda Jr. High; Century is back-up location
  - b. Each student needs to sell at least one ticket that will go directly to the band. The remaining tickets each sells will be applied to their fees.
  - c. Small food/drink items will be available to purchase
  - d. Brook will make tickets
  - e. Parental supervision will be needed
