Century High School Band Private Lesson Scholarship Contract

The following contract forms the requirements that must be met in order for funds to be paid out to the private teachers. These requirements are an ongoing contract. The contract is to protect scholarship money from being abused.

Scholarship Requirements

1. The students must be prepared for all lessons.
2. The student may not miss a lesson without a **24-hour** notice to the private teacher (emergencies will be considered on a case by case basis).
3. The student must show progress on materials in lessons and in class.
4. The student must maintain a minimum of an 85 average in band.
5. The student must maintain a band citizenship grade of satisfactory or better.
6. The student must be academically eligible for **all** band performances.
7. The parent(s) must pay their portion of the lesson on time.
8. The scholarship does not begin until this form is returned with all signatures.
9. In the event that the student does not sign up for band, the following year, the scholarship will be discontinued at the time of registration.
10. **The student must participate in all fundraisers that fund the scholarship program.**

Removal Procedures

The following outlines the procedure for scholarship recipients that do not meet the requirements to keep their scholarship.

1. Warning with a **parent contact.**
2. **Removal** of the scholarship.

*If the scholarship is removed, the student will not be eligible for another private lesson scholarship until the next school year.
